

How to change Tempo of MP3 files.

Windows Media Player

Open file in windows media player
Open View menu
Open Enhancements
Click on play speed setting
And then fiddle with the speed

Audacity

select the track or portion of the track you want the filter applied to, then go to **Effect > Change Tempo**.

From there, you will be given many advanced options, but the most important one is the percent change field. Inputting a percentage greater than zero will speed up track while a negative number will do the opposite.

Amazing Slow Downer

Is intended for musicians wanting to slow down music without changing the pitch. It is very good, you can not only slow and speed up recordings, but you can adjust the tuning if you wish. I find this useful when playing along with recordings that are at a higher pitch "A=444 etc". You can adjust the tuning in cents. The quality of the sound is very well maintained as well.
